WHAT ARE HOME TESTS?

As established by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), home tests for COVID-19 offer reliable, fast results and can be conducted anywhere, regardless of vaccination status and whether or not the person has symptoms.

- Home testing, vaccination, wearing well-fitting masks, and physical distancing help protect you and others by reducing the chances of spreading COVID-19.
- Home tests do **not** detect antibodies that would suggest prior infection, nor do they measure your level of immunity to COVID-19.

WHEN SHOULD I TAKE A COVID-19 TEST?

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that all travelers have tested for COVID-19:

Get tested if:	When to do it:
Has any symptoms of COVID-19.	Immediately
You were exposed to someone with COVID-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Five days after exposure.• If you test negative for COVID-19, consider retesting 1-2 days after your first test.
You will attend a closed event or venue.	Immediately before the venue or as close as possible to the schedule of the event.

WHAT TO DO WHEN I GET A POSITIVE RESULT?

- Upload your test result to the Puerto Rico Department of Health BioPortal. (Follow the instructions on the back of this page.)
- Follow these recommendations:
 - Stay home for at least five days and isolate yourself from other people in your home.
 - Notify the people with whom you have had close contact with the result.
 - If possible, wear an N95 or KN95 mask.
 - Tell your health care provider. Contact them as soon as possible if your symptoms worsen.

WHAT TO DO WHEN I GET A NEGATIVE RESULT?

- Upload your test result to the Puerto Rico Department of Health BioPortal.
- A negative result indicates that the test did not detect the virus but should not rule out infection, especially if you have symptoms.
- Consider repeat testing 24 to 48 hours later. Multiple negative tests increase confidence that you do not carry the virus that causes COVID-19.
