## AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION OF THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND LICENSING OF HOSPITALS IN PUERTO RICO

In accordance with the powers and faculties conferred by Act No. 81 of March 14, 1912, as amended, Act No. 101 of June 26, 1965, as amended, Joint Resolution No. 7 of January 12, 2023 (J. Res. 7-2023), and Act No. 38-2017, as amended, the Secretary of Health intends to amend the Regulation No. 9184 of July 1, 2020, as amended, known as "Regulation for the Construction, Operation, Maintenance and Licensing of Hospitals in Puerto Rico", in order to comply with the provisions of J. Res. 7-2023 which orders the Department of Health to amend the Regulation No. 9184, supra, to establish the requirement that nursing personnel who render direct health services in emergency rooms in hospitals or at the primary level, obtain the necessary training and continuing education on violence and sexual abuse.
