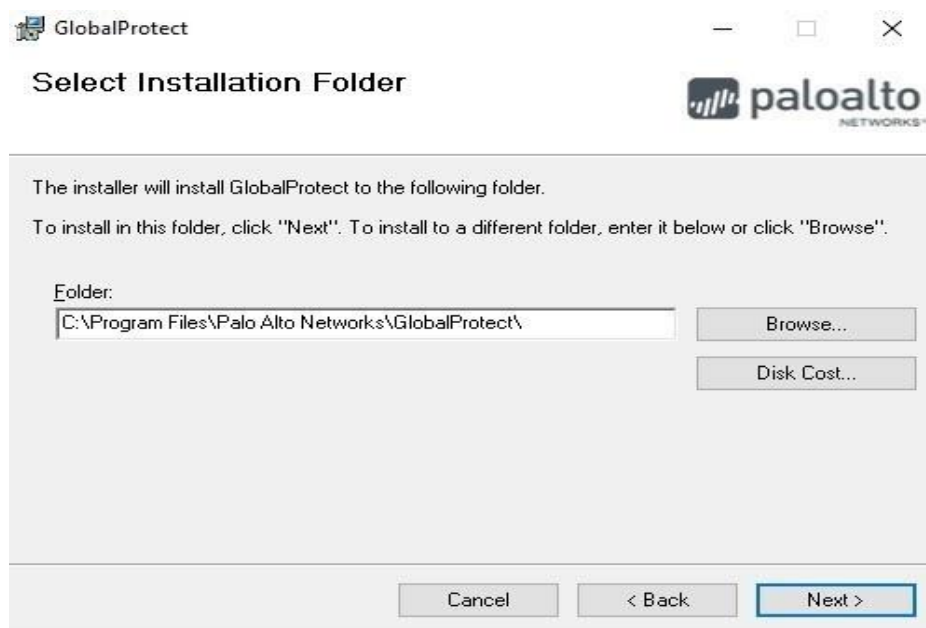
After download double-click on the GlobalProtect agent, and click **NEXT**

## GLOBAL AGENT INSTALLATION

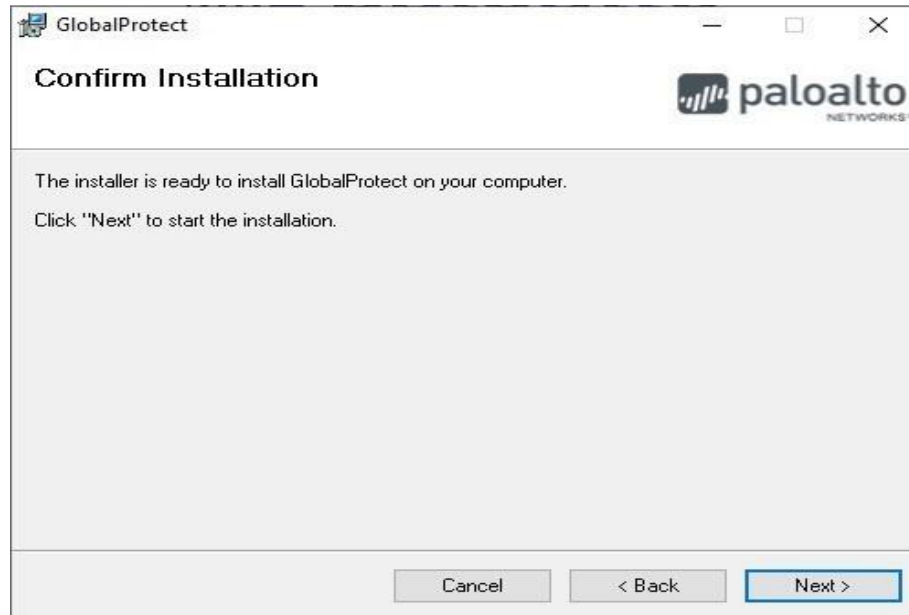
Run the downloaded file and click **NEXT**



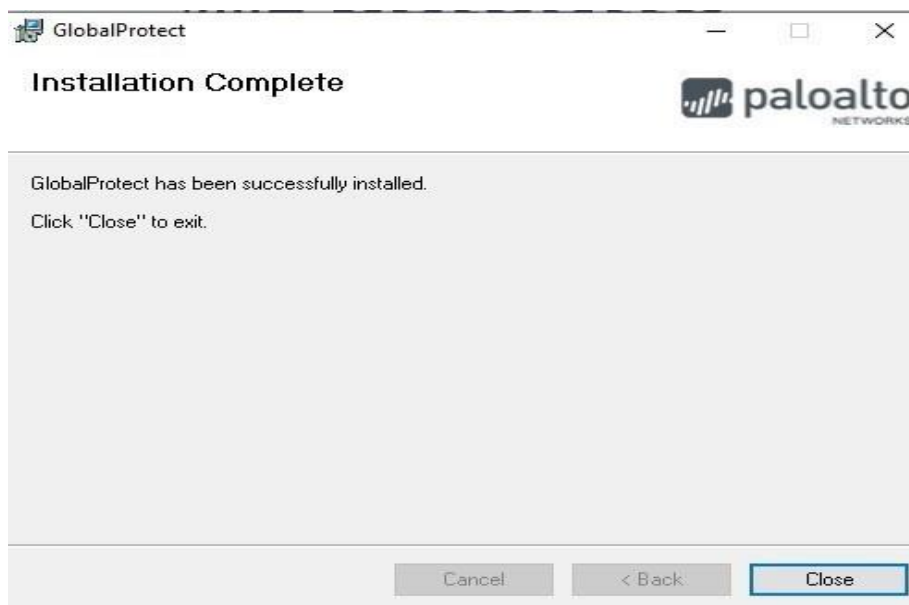
Use default path installation and click **NEXT**

Click **CLOSE** to exit

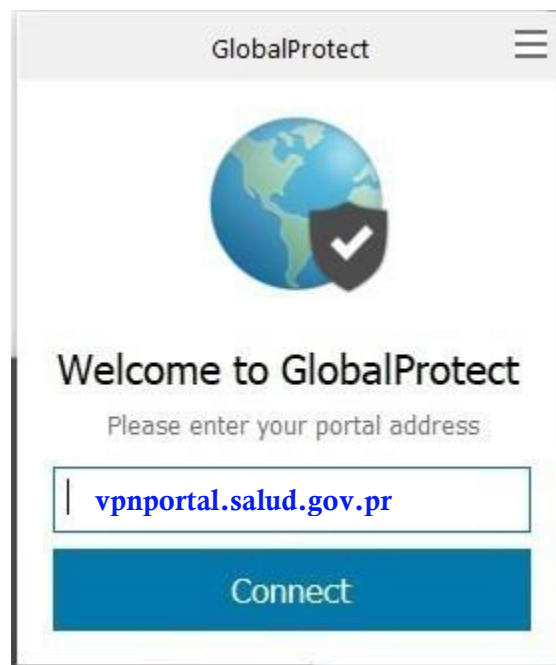


## CONFIGURE VPN

Go to taskbar and click the grayed-out world icon




When the Global Protect window appears, type the portal address, [vpnportal.salud.gov.pr](https://vpnportal.salud.gov.pr), and click **CONNECT**



After the portal address has been entered, the Sign In window appears.  
Type your domain: **odsi\_dmn**, **username** and **password**.
