The Puerto Rico Department of Health (PRDOH), in compliance with the principles of healthy administration and transparency in the process of selection and award of Professional Services contracts, the Department of Health requests Proposals for:

“Maternal Service, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program Implementation in Jayuya and Adjuntas”.

Period of services is subject to the formalization of a contract between the PR Department of Health and the Proponent, and the availability of funds.

The selection of the potential contractor will be notified by email.



The DSPR will appoint an Evaluation Panel that will review and qualify the proposals. Proposals sent after the established time or that are incomplete will not be evaluated.

The DSPR, through its Secretary or through the staff designated by him, will review the proposals submitted and will determine if any of them is capable of signing a professional services contract with the concerned agency of the Government of Puerto Rico. The criteria to use in your selection include, but are not limited to: (i) Bidders Experience; (ii) Bidders Qualifications, (iii) Understanding the project and Requested; (iv) Proposal Cost; (v) Required Documentation; and (vi) any other criterion of trust and confidentiality that is considered prudent and necessary.

The selected provider must have the “Registro Unico de Proveedores” (RUP) issued by the General Services Administration of the Government of Puerto Rico (ASG), through which it certifies its inclusion in the Single Registry of Professional Services Providers, as provided in Act No. 73-2019, as amended, known as the “Puerto Rico Government Procurement Centralization General Services Administration Act of 2019.”

By submitting a proposal in accordance with this Notice, the Proposer acknowledges that:

1. At its sole discretion, the DSPR or its designee may contact the proponents to clarify any doubts or coordinate an interview and presentation in person or virtually, without requiring the presence of the other proponents.
2. The purpose of the notice is to publicize that the Government of Puerto Rico has a service need that will potentially result in the hiring of professional services from an Agency.
3. As a result of this process, no type of right is generated that results in forcing the Government of Puerto Rico to sign a professional services contract.
4. It has the power to bind itself and comply with all the parameters and requirements applicable to the public contracting of professional services.
5. As part of this process, the signing of a non-disclosure agreement may be required.
