REPEAL OF REGULATION NO. 9295 ON COVID-19 VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A HEALTH CERTIFICATE

Regulation No. 9295 of August 5, 2021, was repealed through the special expedited procedure provided by Section 2.13 of Act No. 38-2017, as amended, Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico. Regulation No. 9295 established the physician's obligation to certify that the person has shown evidence of vaccination against COVID-19 as a requirement to issue a health certificate.
