### 3 things to know when visiting Puerto Rico

Follow these CDC's recommendations



1

**Testing is encouraged within 3 to 5 days of arrival in Puerto Rico, regardless of your vaccination status or symptoms associated with COVID-19.**

2

**Once you arrive to Puerto Rico, be aware if you present any symptoms associated with COVID-19.**

3

**Isolate if you have any symptoms associated with COVID-19 or if you test positive for a COVID-19 test, preferably molecular.**
