3 things to know when visiting **Puerto Rico**

Follow these CDC's recommendations



- Testing is encouraged within 3 to 5 days of arrival in Puerto Rico, regardless of your vaccination status or symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- Once you arrive to Puerto Rico, be aware if you present any symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- Isolate if you have any symptoms associated with 3 **COVID-19 or if you test positive for a COVID-19** test, preferably molecular.
