WHAT TO DO AS SOON AS THE WATER COMES BACK ON AFTER A WATER OUTAGE:

AS EASY AS 1, 2, 3

Puerto Rico Aqueduct and Sewer Authority (PRASA) water complies with the Safe Drinking Water Act and is safe for drinking and cooking. The Department of Health monitors it daily to ensure it meets all Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) standards.

When you first get water from PRASA, **let it run on high for 5 minutes** to flush the line.



During the first 72 hours after getting water from PRASA, boil the water.
Once it begins to boil, continue boiling for 3 minutes to make it safe to drink. Beyond 72 hours, the water is safe to drink from the faucet.
