AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION OF THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH NO. 7784 FOR THE ISSUANCE OF HEALTH CERTIFICATES IN PUERTO RICO

The Regulation of the Secretary of Health No. 138-A to amend the Regulation of the Secretary of Health No. 7784 for the Issuance of Health Certificates in Puerto Rico, Regulation No. 9295 of August 5, 2021, was approved through the special procedure provided by Section 2.13 of Act No. 38-2017, as amended, known as the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico. Regulation No. 7784 establishes the obligation of certifying that the person has shown evidence of vaccination against COVID-19 (COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card) as a requirement to issue a health certificate.
